"The Future of the Scottish Fishing Industry"

In 2002, the EU Council of Ministers, following scientific advice, imposed a sharp reduction in cod and other deep sea fishing in the North Sea. This action was seen by many as threatening the viability of the deep sea fleet and the existence of the industry in Scotland. Against this background, the Royal Society of Edinburgh set up an expert panel to investigate the whole issue of fishing policy as it affects Scotland.

This seminar, to be presented by Professor Gavin McCrone, one of the members of the expert panel, will examine and open up for discussion the key findings of the recently published RSE report.
