Restoring Trust – Investment in the twenty-first century

Sir Richard Sykes

Rector of Imperial College and former Chairman of GlaxoSmithKline

This seminar will discuss the findings of a new report, published by Tomorrow's Company, which concludes that the trust and confidence of investors has been damaged; calls for an industry-wide culture change that puts the customer first; and recommends changes in the way institutional investors fulfil their ownership responsibilities. The report warns that the only way for the UK investment system to deliver better value to its customers is for concerted and collective action by the industry itself, starting with a high level statement of what it stands for.

The report is the result of two years of consultation among over 500 practitioners and interest groups representing all parts of the investment chain. It is significant because it represents the views of senior practitioners from all sides of investment, financial services and wealth creation. Unlike recent reports that have reviewed a particular aspect or problem in financial services, the inquiry has sought to take a holistic view of the whole investment system.

The Inquiry Team that produced it was led by Sir Richard Sykes who will present this David Hume Institute seminar.
